This year, the lack of snow and the warm weather on the day of our start up meeting allowed me to get the TR6 out of the trailer and drive it to the meeting. Two others did the same, creating perhaps the largest number of Triumphs ever assembled at one of our start up meetings! Club Director John Gibbs started the meeting by announcing that all of the current club officers have agreed to continue in their roles for 2016. We still encourage anyone to volunteer for any of the club responsibilities however. For example, Tricia Gibbs could use some help with the club newsletter. This could be someone taking over as newsletter editor or just assisting Tricia. The newsletter editor job is made easier when people provide

content so please consider contributing an article that we could publish about you and your Triumph or perhaps an article about a British car event that you attended. John also suggested that we have an official club photographer, someone who would take photos at our events to be used on our Facebook page, in newsletter articles and on the website. We will communicate the new password to all members in good standing prior to making the change so don't forget to renew your membership!

For our party this past January, we changed from a plated dinner to a buffet and that seemed to be very popular however that option is more expensive and requires that we get at least 50 people to sign

Regalia: Click the Regalia Button and follow the instructions to see what Regalia is available.

Classifieds: Check here if you are looking to buy or sell anything Triumph.

Calendar: Our [online calendar](#) is the place to go for up-to-date information about club events. We create a preliminary calendar at our kickoff meeting in March. Event details are often not finalized until a few days in advance of an event, at which time the calendar entry for that event will be updated with the meeting location and time, restaurant information, etc. Over the course of the driving season plans may change due to scheduling conflicts or weather forecasts causing an event to be moved to a different day. If this is due to the weather, this may happen just a day or two before the event so it's a good idea to check the calendar often. The online calendar is updated whenever new information becomes available.

We are using Google Calendar which is a bit quirky but has some useful features that outweigh its shortcomings. It offers multiple views (Week, Month and Agenda) and allows printing up to a year's worth of events at a time. We actually have three calendars merged into one:

- Club Events, shown in British Racing Green
- Other Events of Interest, shown in TR6 Topaz (don't call it orange!), are events sponsored by other clubs that might be of interest to our members
- Holidays, shown in Magenta, to help us schedule around them

Click on the name of the event to bring up a pop-up window containing "When", "Where" and "Description" details for the event. Click on the "map" link in the "Where" information to bring up the event location in Google maps. For non-club events there will usually be a link in the "Description" information to take you to a website with more information. Click on the little "x" (or anywhere else on the calendar) to close the details window.

To print out a list of events, click on the Agenda tab and then click on the little printer icon (next to the word "Print") to bring up a print preview window. Select a date range and check the box to "Print Descriptions" if you want more than just the title, date and location for each event.

If you want to print only the New England Triumphs club events, click on the little triangle next to the "Agenda" tab and make sure only "New England Triumphs Event Calendar" is selected. Then follow the directions above to print the list of events.
